KINDERGARTEN

- ❖ Full Day Program
- ❖ Staffed with one full-time teacher and one assistant teacher.
- ❖ Focus shifts from school readiness to the development of reading and math skills.
- ❖ Weekly “special classes” include music, art, foreign language, library, physical education, and computer (through grade 8)

ELEMENTARY GRADES 1 – 5

- ❖ A strong academic program, including foreign language study, challenges students to reach their full potential.

MIDDLE SCHOOL GRADES 6 – 8

- ❖ The curriculum emphasizes independent critical thinking; this more challenging approach reflects the growing maturity of the Middle School student as they take their next steps on their journey towards High School.
